Guinea Exploration Highlights

- Mapping confirms ironstone formation at surface over +30 square km of the 244 square km Télimélé license, part of the Coastal Project in western Guinea, West Africa.
- Five ironstone samples from Télimélé contain 60-63% Fe and are considered Direct Shipping Ore (DSO) iron product.
- Hematite ore
- Sampling over the rest of the 244 square km Télimélé license has finished: geologist confirms vast outcrops of ironstone, results expected in July.
- 1,946 square kms of additional licenses have been secured over the same ironstone formation, bringing Nemex's total tenure to 2,911 square kms.
- Two Guinean Government-owned rail lines are less than 60km away
- Drill rig & Niton XRF unit purchased for Guinea DSO projects
